Dr. Hofman was born in Bozeman, MT and lived in Calgary, Alberta, Canada, Los Angeles, CA, and Muskegon, MI in his youth. Married to Heidi he has four children and ten grandchildren. A graduate of Calvin University and University of Michigan Medical School, Pediatric Residency was accomplished in Grand Rapids, he joined Alger Pediatrics in 1984.
